1. One copy, certified by the registrar or other recognized official, of the applicant’s **most current (after January 2020)** official high school transcript postmarked **no later than April 11, 2020**.
2. Two letters of recommendation, **no more than 1-page**; one from a high school teacher and the other from a teacher, counselor, administrator or person who can objectively assess your abilities and character. (Please no family members). Do not submit more than two letters. Please ask your references to address the following:
 - Reference’s position or title
 - Indicate how long and in what capacity you have known the applicant. Describe the applicant’s motivation and potential for academic success. Please be specific.
 - Describe the applicant’s distinctive qualities or unique characteristics that you have personally observed that make the applicant particularly qualified to receive a TPI Scholarship
3. Essay Topic: “What a College Education Means to Me” **The essay must be typed.** A minimum of 100 words is required.
4. Completed Application.
